As the challenges of global shortages do affect some aspects of our supply chain and create present challenges, purchasing has been doing a fantastic job of meeting our daily needs.

Last year in the same time frame there were 32 spreaders sold vs. this year at 49 spreaders sold.

We have seen an increase of spreader service needs with the most recent spreader being a John Deere 780 coming from as far as New Jersey to our door for repairs. Even with service, we have been able to keep assembly production running optimally.

Our welding department is on pace and keeping with the flow of the spreader/ harvester parts coming through for production.

The prototype litter spreader is currently running with very good reports on spread achievements. Customer reports are very happy with it's abilities.
